





The Vice-Chancellor's Blue Carpet Scholarship

- The scholarship is awarded to applicants who have excelled in the final examinations in 2022 and wish to study at the University of Cape Town.
- The scholarship is valued at R100 000 per year, and is valid for up to three years subject to the student being named on their faculty's Dean's Merit List.
- The scholarship covers charges relating to tuition and residence. The balance can be used for laptops, books and other study needs.

Terms and Conditions

The applicant must have passed the Independent Examination Board (IEB) or NSC examination in 2022 and is

- one of the top five 2023 UCT applicants in the category; or
- one of the top 10 achievers in the Mathematics, English or Computer Science Olympiad in 2022
- one of the top 10 performers in the Western Cape or one of the top 15 performers nationally
- the scholarship may be held concurrently with an external award or financial aid, but replaces entrance scholarships should they be awarded. It is awarded at a pro-rated value for students qualifying for the staff tuition rate.

The Vice-Chancellor Scholarship awardees will receive correspondence from UCT in January 2023 once the NSC and IEB results have been released.
