UCT confirms attempted library disruption

The University of Cape Town confirms that an attempt was made on Tuesday morning by a small group of students to disrupt services in the library. The university is also looking into disruptions by the same group to a small number of lectures.

The library was temporarily evacuated but is now in the process of reopening. Members of the UCT executive as well as SRC members engaged the disrupters. They have now left the library area.

Academic and administrative activities are continuing.
