Ahead of World AIDS Day on 1 December, the Desmond Tutu Health Foundation (DTHF) based at the University of Cape Town (UCT) will host a webinar on the history of the HIV epidemic and what lies ahead in the fight to end AIDS.

Titled "The HIV Epidemic 40 years on", the webinar will be presented by Professor Linda-Gail Bekker, the DTHF's chief operating officer and member of UCT's Institute of Infectious Disease and Molecular Medicine.

Professor Bekker will discuss the breakthroughs in HIV treatment, care and prevention that have been accomplished so far; the role that community activism, service delivery, and policy have played; and what still needs to be achieved to reach the goal of an AIDS-free generation.
